

VPN remote access


To access the SURF network remotely:

Use the JunosPulse client that can be installed and setup as below, this is the equivalent to the older “network connect”, which bypasses the browser login and allows you to directly connect to the network. This will allow you to login into Docushare or go directly to your data.

After installation select add a connection:

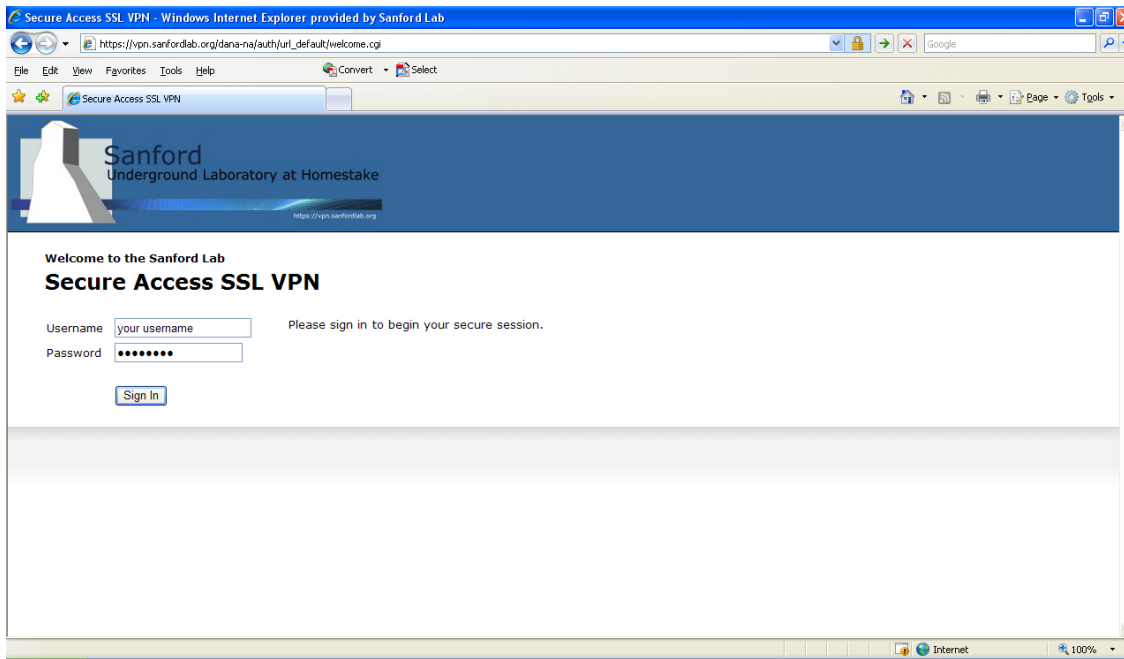
